Position Purpose

To operate and mix live audio for services and events, ensuring clear, balanced, and professional sound that supports preaching, teaching, music, and community activities. Helping congregants and visitors engage fully, connect with one another, and join in worship and service to God.

Time Commitment

- Arrival Time: 7:30 AM
- Serving Time: 7:30 AM during band practice to end of 2nd service
- LIVESTREAM ONLY: arrive 15 min prior to 2nd service, run livestream audio during 2nd service
- Frequency: Flexible, based on your availability - *minimum once a month*

Primary Responsibilities

- Helping make sure cameras are operational before service and event times
- Learn communication cues to speak to camera operators during recording
- Switching between camera video feeds to make sure the viewer can focus on what's being featured at that moment
- Understand basic camera knowledge to communicate with operators when a camera setting might need to be changed based on what you see on your monitor
- As it's needed, activating the interpretation software for those in attendance whose English is not their first language
- Working with lyrics/graphics volunteer to display text and graphics on screen
- Starting, stopping, and monitoring the livestream

Serving Principles and Guidelines

- Serve with humility, grace, and a servant's heart.
- Be present and prepared for your area of service as assigned.
- Work in harmony with your team and leaders.
- Represent Christ in your attitude, speech, and actions.
- Follow any ministry-specific instructions provided by your leader

- Pray for those you serve and for your fellow volunteers.
- Encourage and build up your team members.
- Seek opportunities to mentor and be mentored.
